

North Clackamas Parks and Recreation Scholarship Fund Scholarship Policy

1. The North Clackamas Parks and Recreation Scholarship Fund's scholarships are available for NCPRD sponsored programs and NCPRD residents only.
2. All scholarship requests will be reviewed and awarded by the Parks District Staff.
3. Scholarships may only be awarded for a percentage of the full amount of the program fee. Scholarships will be awarded from available allocated resources, excluding team sport fees, facility rentals, food and beverage and assessed late charges. Scholarship assistance includes only the program fee, not the additional money that may be needed for equipment or materials not included in the program fees.
4. NCPRD Scholarship requests will be awarded or denied based on verifiable information provided by the applicant and the criteria established. NCPRD Staff may authenticate the need for financial assistance.
5. NCPRD Scholarships must be applied for at least two weeks prior to the program. The number of scholarships approved may be restricted by the number of participants registered for any program.
6. NCPRD Scholarship assistance will be limited to one program per year per person. Two per family per year but not for the same program.
7. Scholarships are granted or denied based on financial need as determined by NCPRD staff.
8. For tracking purposes, reports will be provided to NCPRD on a quarterly basis.
