Clackamas County, OR – Dog owners are encouraged to bring their four-legged friends to North Clackamas Parks and Recreation District's (NCPRD) new FIDO Friday event at 6 p.m. Aug. 10 at North Clackamas Park, 5440 S.E. Kellogg Creek Drive, Milwaukie. FIDO Friday brings dog owners, vendors and pet-focused non-profits together in an effort to raise money to support Meals on Wheels in North Clackamas County.

Dogs and their people are invited to North Clackamas Park to enjoy a pet-vendor expo, the North Clackamas dog park, and a "Movie in the Park" during this family-friendly event. Dinner and snacks, sold by the Milwaukie Center Nutrition Program, will be available for purchase.

Local pet advocacy group, FIDO, will be on hand offering low-cost rabies vaccinations, microchipping, and activities to educate and entertain children and families.

The pet vendor expo will be set up from 6-9 p.m. August 10 at North Clackamas Park and the movie, Bolt, will begin at dusk (around 9 p.m.)

The cost is \$5 for ages 13+, \$2 for kids under 13, and dogs are free. All proceeds go to support the Milwaukie Center's Meals on Wheels program.
