Additionally, I understand that I (or my representative) must be at North Clackamas Aquatic Park and set up by no later than 5 p.m. on October 30th. If I arrive late, I may be stuck in traffic and may not be able to enter the Park. I plan on staying the entire time and understand there are 7 time slots total and the last session of children need to experience the same as the first session of children. Each time slot takes about 30 minutes and will have approximately 60 cars participate. The last attendee vehicle will pass by my area at 8:30 p.m. and clean-up is between 8:30 – 9 p.m.
