Objective:

With supervision the lifeguard works to better ensure the safety of patrons at the North Clackamas Aquatic Park by enforcing policies, preventing injury and responding to emergencies appropriately. Reports to: Shift Coordinators, Aquatic Supervisors, Aquatic Park Manager

Hiring Process:

This position is currently open until filled. We reserve the right to close this recruitment at any time.

Primary Duties (to include, but not limited to):

- Maintains constant oversight of patrons within the facility and works to ensure their safety.
- Immediately and appropriately responds to all emergency situations.
- Presents a professional appearance and provides exceptional customer service.
- Aids to preserve a high level of overall safety and cleanliness, as outlined by nationally recognized organizations, at the North Clackamas Aquatic Park.
- Routinely takes part in mandatory monthly and biannual staff trainings.
- Upholds all rescue skills and maintains current certifications.

Required Minimum Qualifications:

- Lifeguard certification, First Aid and CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer. Must complete blood-borne pathogen training after hire. The ability to comfortably interact with the public and provide exceptional customer service is required.
- Must be able to stand for extended periods of time.
- Must be able to perform all rescue, first aid, CPR and AED skills as outlined by the American Red Cross Lifeguard Certification and Training and the North Clackamas Aquatic Park procedures.
- Must be able to walk, stoop, sit, and bend to provide assistance to guests and to demonstrate swimming skills.
- Must be able to speak to, hear and see participants and employees.
- Lifeguard/Instructors need to be able to perform repetitive high energy movements of the arms, legs and torso for skills relating to aquatic rescues, CPR and swimming instruction.
- Must be able to lift and carry up to 75 pounds.

Preferred background knowledge, skills and abilities:

- Must possess current Lifeguard, First Aid, CPR/AED and have excellent customer service skills.
