Call to Order

DAC meeting was called to order by Jeanette DeCastro at 5:32 p.m. A quorum was present.

Action Items

- Approval of DAC Meeting Summary
 - o The summary from the DAC meeting held on November 8, 2023, was approved with one minor edit, amending the attendance record.

Discussion Agenda

- Jeanette DeCastro opened the floor for discussion on elections for chair/vice chair.
- ACTION: Joel Bergman made a motion to nominate Jeanette DeCastro for Chair and Mark Elliot for Vice Chair.
 - o Jeanette accepts the nomination for the chair position, and Mark accepts the nomination.
 - o Grover Bornefeld seconded the nomination.
 - o No other nominations were received.
 - o DAC members voted to approve Jeanette DeCastro as Chair and Mark Elliot as Vice Chair. Motion passed unanimously by show of hands.

DAC Recruitment Discussion

o Jeanette DeCastro opened the floor for discussion on DAC recruitment.

- o Grover would like the DAC to consider nominating committees for the current open DAC positions and future upcoming open positions.
- o Joel Bergman expressed a desire to continue forward with recruiting for current openings without committee formation in the essence of time.
- o Jeff Munns, counsel, provided insight into rules regarding recruitment and nominee subcommittee formation for recruitment.
- Jeanette DeCastro suggested reaching out to prior interested parties from subarea 3 for recruitment.
- o Grover suggested the process for recruitment is nominating committees make recommendations to the DAC on potential candidates, if nominating committees are not formed an interview process would begin.
- o Cindy asked for additional clarification on the nominating committees.
- o Lisa Batey suggested active CPOs be conduits for candidates.
- o Counsel advised openings would be published on County and NCPRD websites.
- o Jeff Munns, County Counsel, provided additional bylaw clarification, on nomination committees. If they do not currently exist, a prior procedure is in place. He suggests moving forward in that manner.
- o Gary Schmidt, County Administrator, states an approved recruitment plan is in place with the Board of Directors. Staff will follow this plan, working with the BOD on nominating committees and reaching out to the DAC as needed.

24-25 Budget Process

- o Cindy Becker presented a PowerPoint (Included in the packet) on the upcoming 24-25 budget cycle and budget formation process.
- o Grover Bornefeld requested better breakdowns for fund balances and materials and services in the future.
- o Paul Savas clarified that NCPRD does not receive County General Funds and is a separate entity.
- o Kia Selley provided clarification and information on individual capital projects being considered for FY24-25.
